June 4th @ Johnson Air ETO Incentives, OSHA and NAECA



The ORACCA June 4, 2015 meeting will be held at the Johnson Air, 2220 SE 9th Ave., Portland, OR. 97214,

ETO Incentives

Ted Weintraut will cover the cash incentives for Energy Trust's Existing Homes program (with likely guest speaker Kirk Douglas from Energy Trust's Existing Multifamily program). Together they will be able to review what incentives are available for HVAC systems installed in existing residential housing stock throughout Oregon as well as some areas of SW Washington. We will also include information on Oregon state tax credits. This way audience members can quote incentives to customers with confidence to help close sales.

NAECA? New Water Heat Rules

On April 16, 2015, the Department of Energy (DOE) will make effective its new energy efficiency mandates, as part of the National Appliance and Energy Conservation Act (NAECA).

This update will affect all household appliances manufactured for sale in the U.S., and Canada will soon follow in their implementation of similar energy efficiency upgrades. This new update was first announced in April 2010. Paul Stolten and Steve Magnuson with Hollabaugh Bros., will bring everyone up to speed on what effect this will have on your water heater sales.

Part of this efficiency standards update will require nearly all residential electric, oil, gas and tankless gas water heaters to carry higher Energy Factor (EF) ratings. The new rule does not preclude the installation of non-compliant products that are manufactured before April 16, 2015.

OSHA Compliance Issues

We will have two speakers. Gina Teal with LaPorte & Assoc. She will be presenting a service that we are offering for all attendees called INSource. It is a Safety/OSHA Compliance/HR resource. This has over 7500 ready to use templates that can be branded to the end user. Relevant and timely material is created every week. For example – the recent laws in Washington and Oregon have resulted in HR pieces talking about Marijuana in the workplace.

Second is Russ Reasoner with Oregon OSHA. He is speaking on the OSHA Consultative services – which is separate and confidential from OSHA enforcement.

What is Oregon OSHA Consultative Services and how is it different from Or-

 Consultation is a no-cost service available for any place of employment to help you anticipate, identify and assess safety, health and ergonomic hazards.

They write your business a report containing the hazardous employee exposure(s), exposure severity, and recommendations to correct or eliminate the hazard or reduce the exposure. We do not cite violations or assess monetary penalties, unlike the Compliance-side who is required by law to cite and assess monetary penalties based on severity and probability of employee hazard exposure.

• There is a legislative "firewall' preventing them from sharing client information with Compliance. They keep all consultation information confidential and have a confidential agreement between your company and their office.

 They can work with you on several levels:

Comprehensively (like a comprehensive inspection without the worry of monetary penalties)

- Specifically
- Training
- · Presentation/speeches
- · Safety and Health Management
- · SHARP development
- VPP

How can Oregon OSHA Consultative Services help me keep my employees safe?

- a. Anticipate, identify and assess safety, health and ergonomic hazards.

- d. Provide you a comprehensive report that covers:

Hazards identified and means or methods to correct hazards

Safety and Health Management, Relevant Oregon OSHA specific codes

Why should I call on Oregon OSHA Consultative Services for help?

a. They know the codes and can help you identify which codes are particular to your business, reducing your time and frustration.

b. They have the knowledge and skill to anticipate, identify and assess hazards that you may not have been aware, and make control recommendations.

 They have the resources to get you objective information you need to make sound decisions, and

d. You don't have to – you have a right to call you workers' compensation insurance company for the same services or hire a private safety/health/ergonomics firm to provide you similar services.

e. You may want to participate in Oregon OSHA SHARP (Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program) or VPP.

When can I call on Oregon OSHA Consultation for services and what should I expect?

Any employer representation or manager-type employee can call us on the weekdays from 8-5. In the Portland area a consultant is scheduled phone duty, to take consultation requests, answer your question related to safety health or ergonomics, and help you make sense of a mired of code requirements that may affect your business.

After the consultation visit you will receive by mail or e-mail the consultants confidential report. If during the request all three disciplines were agreed on, then you can expect three separate visits and three separate reports, unless otherwise requested.

What are the costs and benefits associated with an Oregon OSHA consultation?


