THE CHANGES IN EFFICIENCY HVAC

Anyone who is selling HVAC equipment in North America should attend this meeting, as all unitary equipment ratings will change effective January 1, 2023.

ORACCA's October meeting will be a presentation by Jim Wheeler (Ruud District Sales Manager), who will discuss how these changes came about, and how they may impact certain federal / local incentives going forward.

Mar-Hy Distributors has provided ORACCA with a multi-page PDF (created by Ruud) detailing the changes and how they will impact the various regions across the United States.

Effective in 2023, we will see significant changes in energy efficiency criteria and ratings that will affect residential and commercial equipment throughout the U.S. Soon afterward will be the national phase down of hydrofluorocarbon (HFC) refrigerants, which will mean a transition to lower global warming potential (GWP) refrigerants for air conditioning., A2L groups

The next set of energy efficiency increases will impact newly-manufactured residential and commercial equipment and will take effect on January 1, 2023. For single-phase residential and light commercial central air conditioning systems, the requirements will vary by region.

There is a huge change in how air conditioning efficiency is rated after January 1, 2023, which will increase the prices consumers will pay for minimum efficiency air conditioner and heat pump replacements. The federal government changed their rating system to account for the electrical consumption of the indoor fan that moved the air inside the home

THE CHANGES IN EFFICIENCY FOR HVAC EQUIPMENT

ORACCA ... Definitions

SEER: Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio. Specifically, the BTUs used for cooling by a system divided by the watts of power it uses over temperatures ranging from 64-105 degrees.

EXAMPLE:

- 24,000 btu/2400 watts = 10 SEER.
- 24,000 btu/1600 watts = 15 SEER (more efficient)

SEER2:

New efficiency rating startiNg 1/1/23, now include extra watts of power used by the fan in a typical home installation.

• 24,000 btu/1600 watts + 60 fan watts = 14.4 SEER2

EER: Efficiency of system at 95 degrees, not a range as in seer. Usually is lower, since the units produce more btus and consume less power in cooler temps.

HSPF: Heating Seasonal Performance Factor. A rating for heat pumps, heating BTUs divided by watts.

An Internet search on "SEER2" will bring up web pages from the major manufacturers and equipment distributors. Almost all of them have similar sites.

All air conditioning systems purchased in the north region that do not meet the SEER2 requirements cannot be installed after January 1, 2023.

All HVAC systems installed in the north region are determined SEER2 compliant based on each systems manufactured date. The big change is the efficiency level that can be installed after 1/1/23 is now 13.4 SEER2 (equivalent to 14 SEER), up from 13 SEER today. Heat Pumps and Single Package Products (SPP) are affected as well, with raised SEER2 guidelines.
