HVAC Industry and the CoVid-19 Pandemic!!

In this day and age of CoVid-19 and its effect on our lives, contractors have an incredible opportunity to generate business and help the people in their communities. First is the knowledge to address the various situations in dwelling is paramount to installing solutions to spread of the virus. IAQ, comprised of ventilation, humidification, filtration and purification provided by the heating and air-conditioning

In buildings with old or inflexible systems, technicians might consider upgrading HVAC hardware. Some of the most important might include these:


• Replacing fixed-speed fan motors with variablespeed ones to enhance the control of airflow and allow for a minimum setting that produces lower speed airflow
