Why you should attend ORACCA's The March meeting? Answer! Because it is the annual Utility Program Update. Presenting will be representatives of NW Natural, PGE, Trade Allies NW and Clark County PUD.



NW Natural

Chris Kroeker will be presenting for NW Natural on RNG (renewable natural gas) procurement and hydrogen development activities.

Renewable natural gas (RNG), also known as sustainable natural gas

(SNG) or biomethane, is a biogas which has been upgraded to a quality similar to fossil natural gas and having a methane concentration of 90% or greater.[1] By increasing the concentration of methane to a similar level as natural gas, it becomes possible to distribute the gas to customers via the existing gas grid and use in existing appliances



Presenting PGE will be Matt Tidwell, Manager of Environmental Policy in

Government Affairs at PGE, focuses on energy efficiency and building electrification.

He has been at PGE for the past two years and before that worked at the Bonneville Power Administration for eleven years on energy efficiency and strategic planning.

Overview: The presentation will identify the critical role HVAC contractors play in helping PGE and its customers get to a carbon free future, address how HVAC fits into the bigger clean energy picture, and how PGE and HVAC contractors can partner and help one another.

Oregon State approved CCB CEU credits for Contractors Business licenses

ORACCA is a source for continuing education units. Many of our monthly meetings qualify for NATE CEUs and or CCB CE's. In addition, we are developing a library of on line on demand videos that also qualify for NATE CEU's. To help clarify the CEU issue, NATE requires that each person participate in ongoing training to maintain their certification. NATE requires 16 CEU hours every two years, in order to keep the certification active.

The Construction Contractors Board, which is responsible for issuing business licenses in the State of Oregon also requires continuing education. This program is for existing contractors who must complete continuing education every two years to renew their licenses. Unless exempt, all residential contractors need the following continuing education every two year license period: 3 hours of CCB laws, regulations and business practices classes, PLUS, 5 hours of other approved courses that relate to business practices or your trade. THE CHANGES IN EFFICIENCY HVAC EQUIPMENT

Anyone who is selling HVAC equipment in North America should have attended this meeting, as all unitary equipment ratings will change effective January 1, 2023.

ORACCA's October meeting will be a presentation by Jim Wheeler (Ruud District Sales Manager), who will discuss how these changes came about, and how they may impact certain federal / local incentives going forward.

There is a huge change in how air conditioning efficiency is rated after January 1, 2023, which will increase the prices consumers will pay for minimum efficiency air conditioner and heat pump replacements.

ORACCA's September meeting was a presentation on **Best Practices** for HVAC companies, presented by ORACCA Contractor members who have been there.

Why do ORACCA members and other HVAC companies need this discussion? Most small business owners of HVAC companies do not have a deep or accurate understanding of business fundamentals, especially overhead.

John Karasaki, PGE moderated the presentation using a target audience: \$1-3 million revenue companies that want to grow or at least have something truly profitable to sell for retirement, or for their next generation.

Say Farewell to R-410A Refrigerants??
