Are you up to date with Residential Energy Codes?

Mark Heizer, lead official with the State of Oregon Building Codes Division will share with us Changes to codes at the state level.

His presentation will be an overview of what will be new for Energy and Mechanical provisions when the 2023 Oregon Residential Specialty Code takes effect, followed by Q&A for other statewide issues.

What's new locally?

The City of Portland will be well represented by Janell Piercy, David Barton, and Paul Ilg introducing the new real time inspections pilot program. They will detail for us how to schedule an inspection, how to make the remote video call and how to do the remote video inspection. They will also cover the proccess for the minor label program, followed by a Q&A session.

Also representing the city of Portland will be Matt Rozzell and Sarah Daley to discuss other changes with the city. Please plan to attend and have your questions ready as this is the first time we have been able to have code officials at our meetings since COVID changed our lives.
